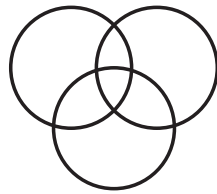

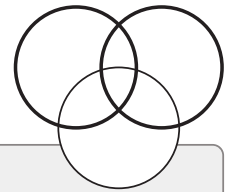

Deeply reflect on each diagram and understand its essence. Take the time to look in to yourself and see how you can apply it in your path of life.

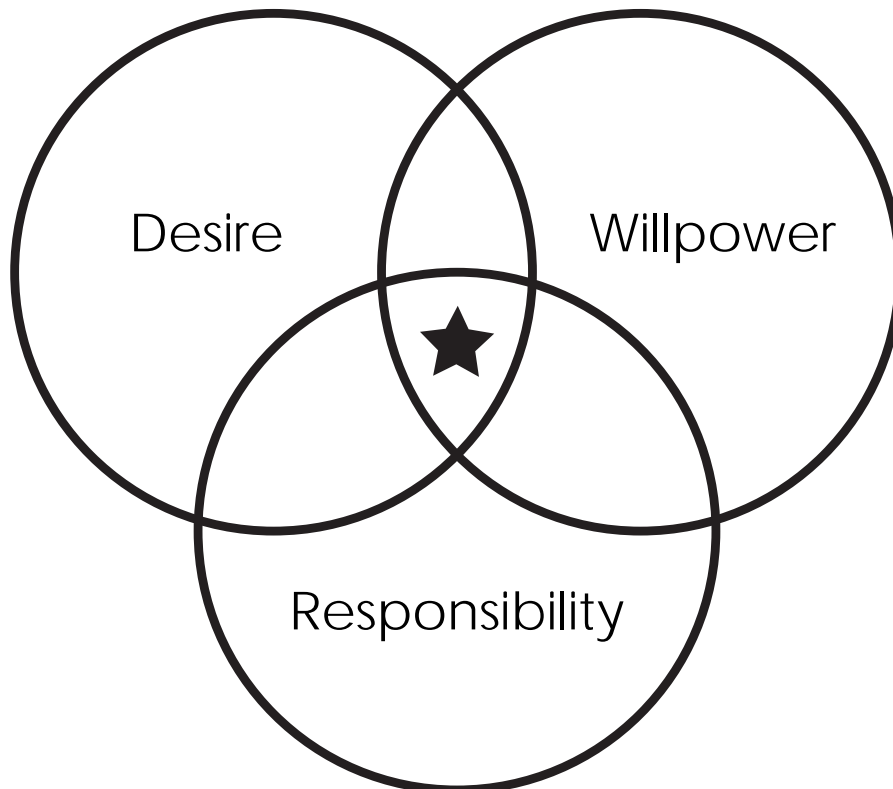


The Absorption Method

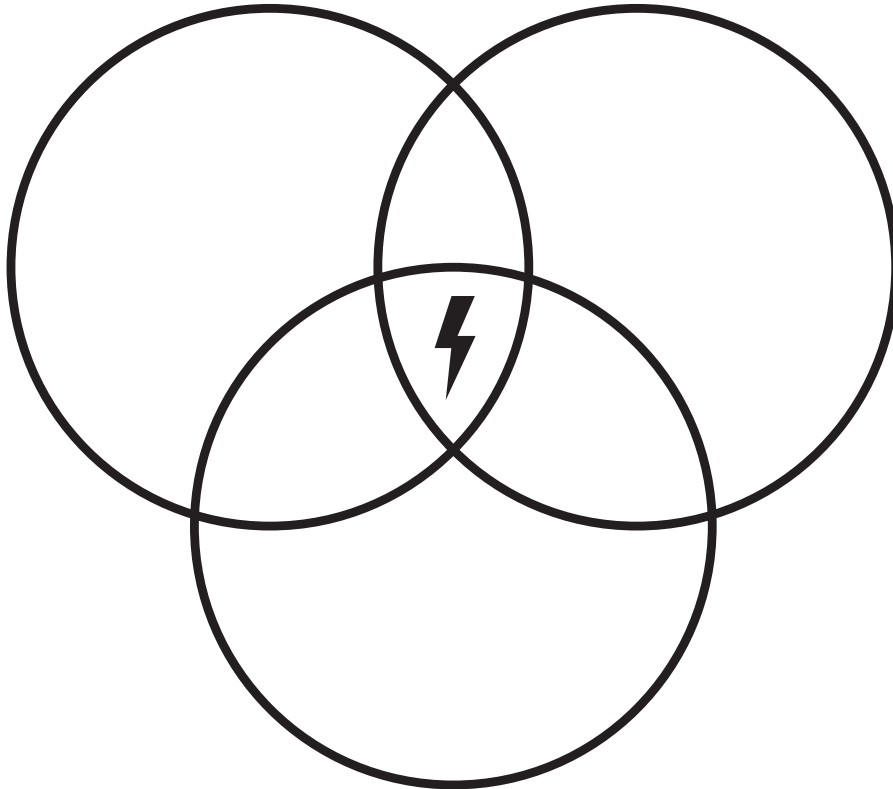
Keep in your pocket (or smartphone) copies of the diagrams you think best reminds you of your weak points. Keep them there till you'll overcome those weaknesses.

Each effective leadership trait or skill consists of three qualities. The one who can combine the use of the relevant three qualities at any given situation can become a leader



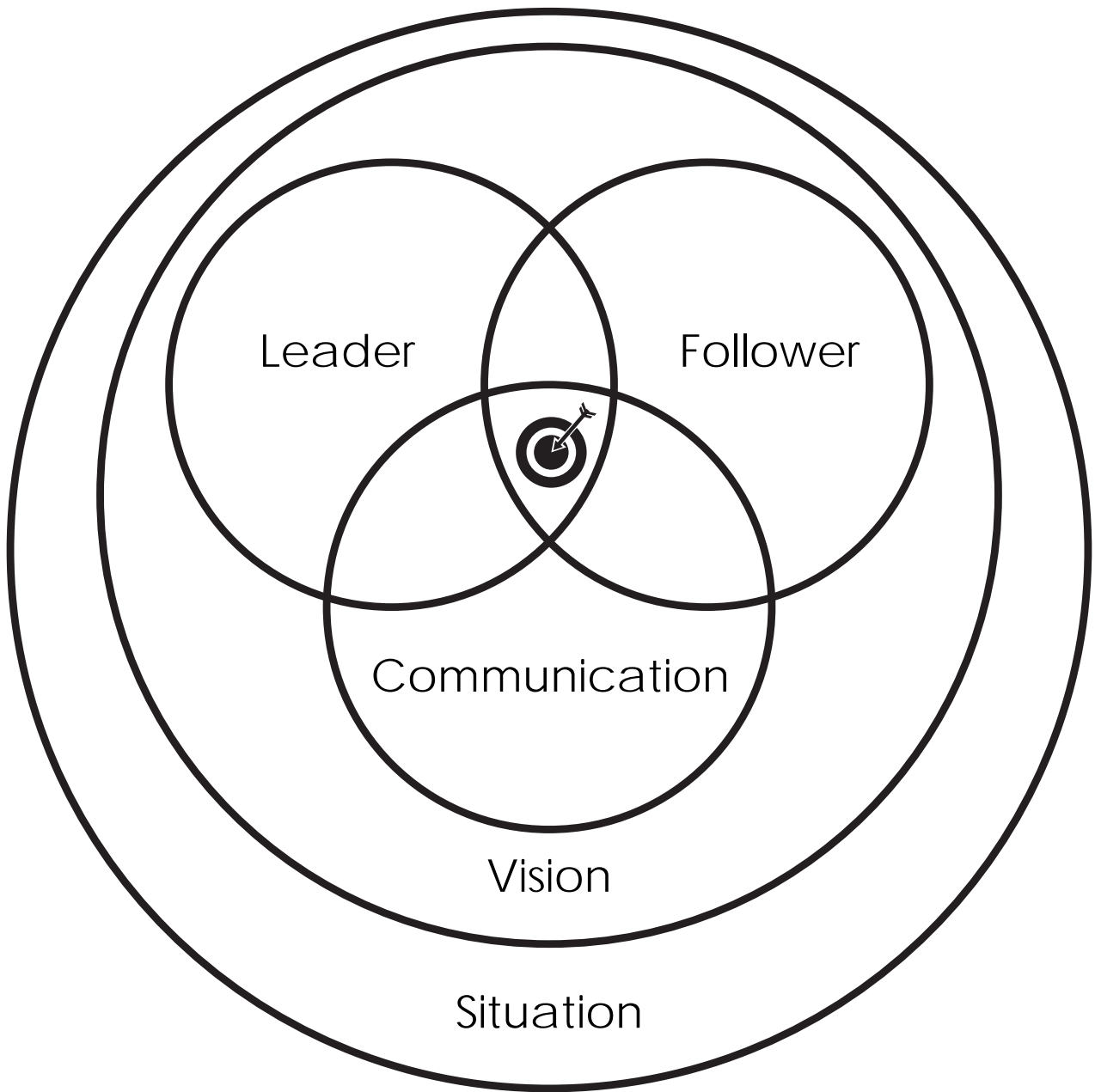

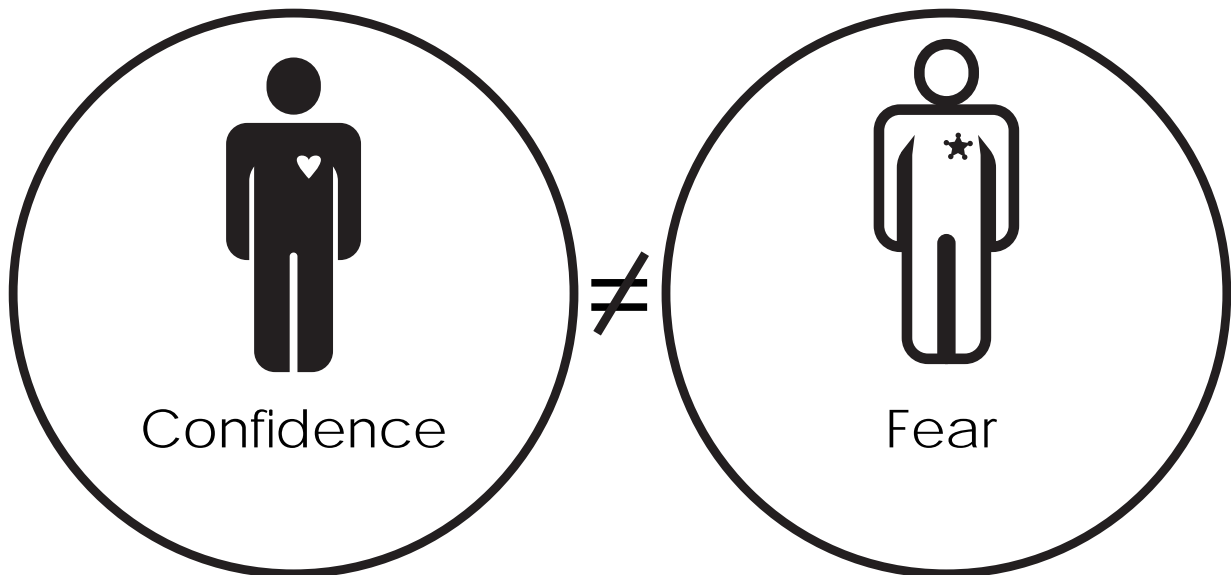
What is leadership and what it's got to do with greatness?

What does it takes to be a leader and what are the three types of leaders.

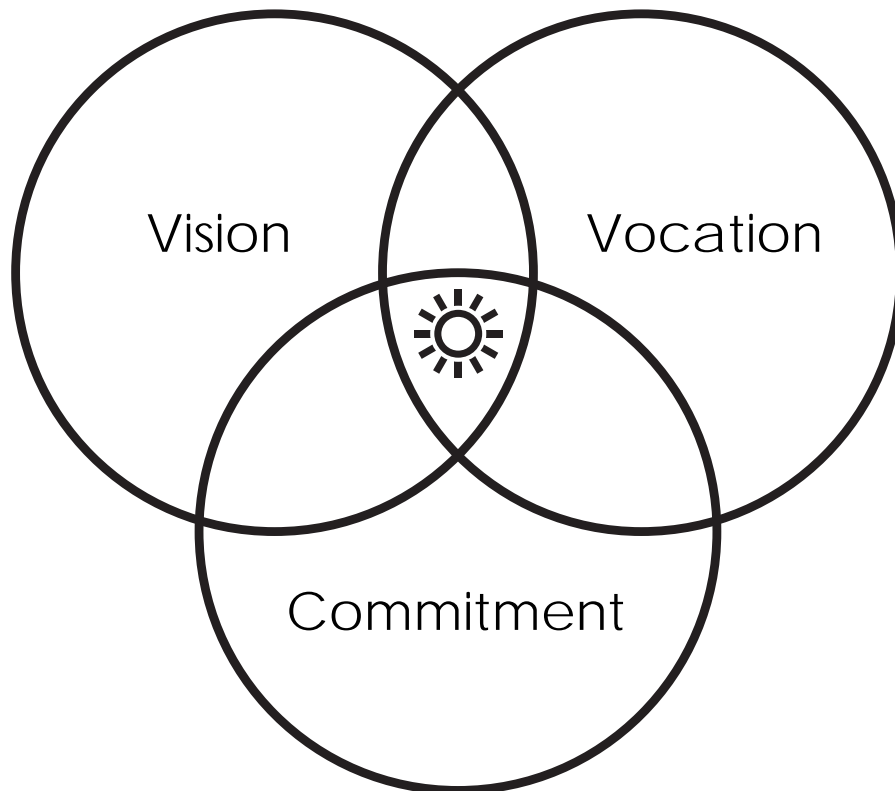


Leadership is the ability to inspire oneself or others and motivate them to achieve a mutual goal out of their own free will.

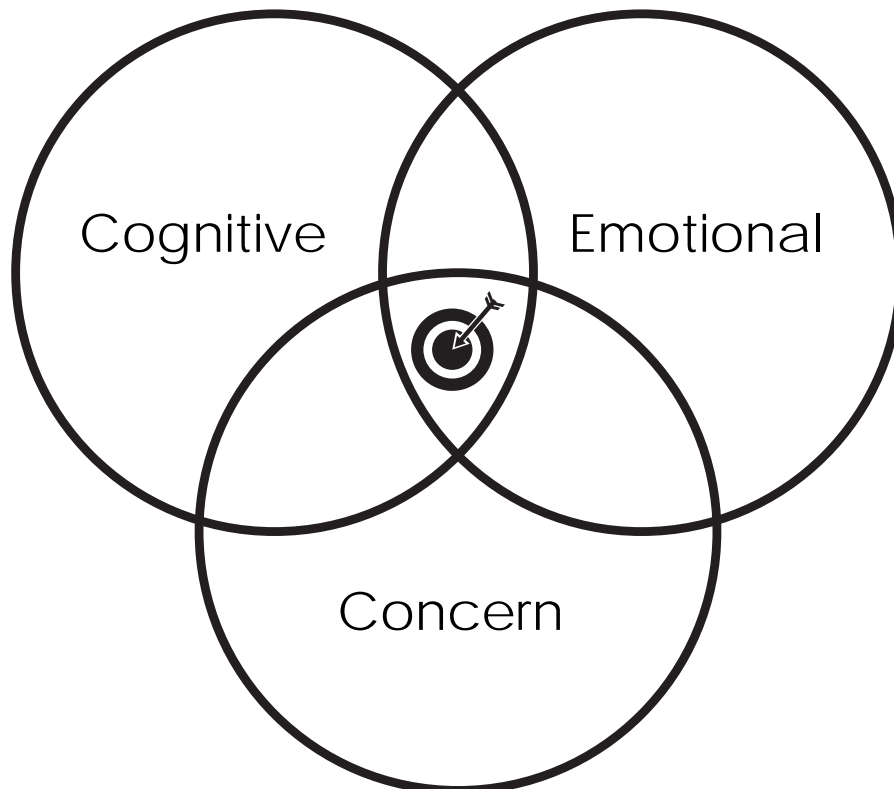
Leader Vs. Boss



Motivation achieves higher goals than authority and orders do. A leader motivates people by inspiration and engagement, he is not necessarily their boss. A leader has followers, a boss has obedient.



Greatness ensues only as a side effect of a leadership way of life. Greatness fruits are Self-Actualization, self-fulfillment and joy of personal accomplishments



In order to achieve his goals and inspire his followers a leader should own three abilities:

Cognitive – Perspective thinking

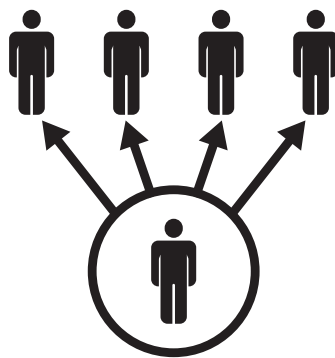
Emotional - Attentiveness to the inner emotional world of others

Concern - Ability to act as needed

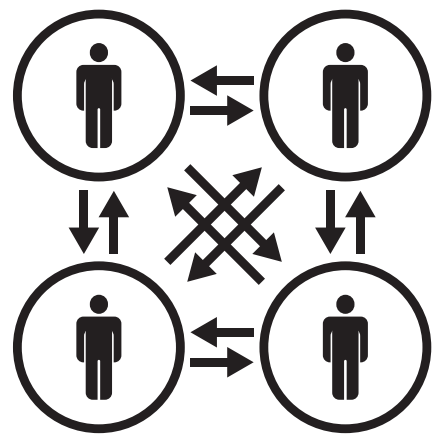
The Three Types of Leaders

Cluster Leader

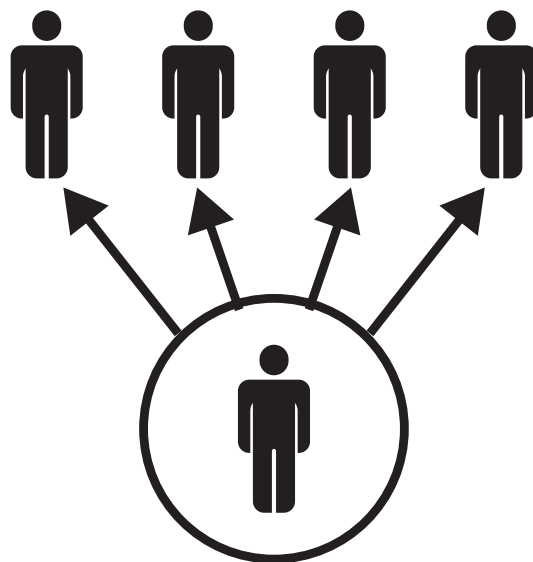
Self-Leader



A person who is committed to his vision, act the best he can adding a real value, fulfilling his vocation and taking full responsibility for the consequences of his doing.

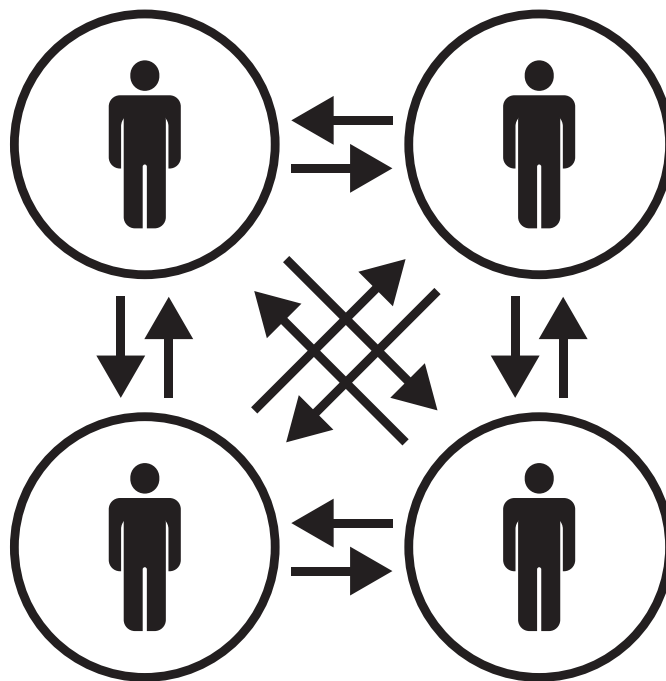
Also known as the Authentic Leader.

Mass-Leader



A Leader who inspires his followers, motivating them to achieve a mutual goal.

Cluster Leader



A group of Leaders who inspires each other and acting together to achieve a mutual goal.

Also known as: Multi-Leader, No-Ego Leader and Beehive Leaders.
